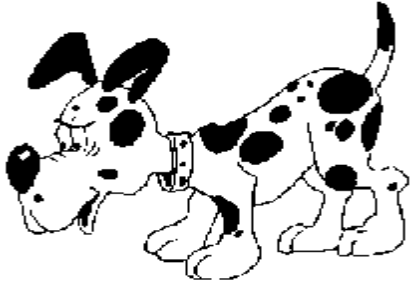


Animals on the University of Kansas Campus

3-202 Animals Prohibited to Run at Large

It is unlawful for any person to permit any dog or cat or other animal to run at large

An animal is not at large if:

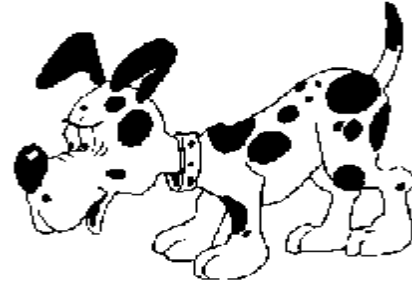
- ☞ The animal is firmly attached to leash or chain under the physical control of the owner or keeper.

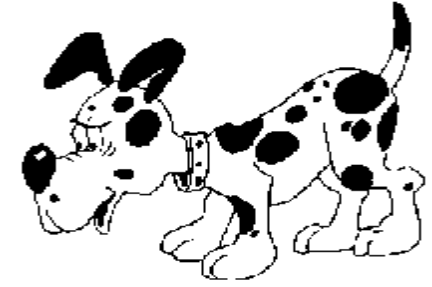
